

Imagine living with no nighttime. Alaska is known for its long summer days, and in the northernmost parts of the state, the sun doesn't set for about eighty days.

Since Alaska is accessible yearround by air, land, or sea, you
can choose to combine your
mode of travel—arriving by air
and departing by sea, or driving
to Alaska and then boarding
the ferry for the trip home. Each
will offer a unique perspective: see the
coastline by ferry or cruise ship, or catch glimpses
of certain rare wildlife by taking the open road.

The northern lights, one of the world's Seven Natural Wonders, will be something magical. The aurora borealis is a natural display of iridescent color dancing across the night sky. They've rightfully earned a spot on many travelers' bucket lists. The best time to witness this magic is October through April.

The glaciers in Alaska are amazing! No matter where you are, you will be face to face with at least one of these icy mammoths. Highlights include places like Glacier Bay National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and named a Cruise Wonder of the World by Condé Nast Traveler. Farther north is the breathtaking Tracy Arm Fjord and College Fjord and Hubbard Glacier.

You can do more than just look.
You can touch, glide, or soar
above them since all the cruise
ships offer optional excursions for
further glacial exploration. They often
combine helicopter/hiking tours that put
you square on the surface of these massive ice beds.

Take a flightseeing tour over the glaciers, kayak around them, or even ride across one on a dogsled.

Alaska is a dream for watching nature. Most of us haven't had the opportunity to see moose grazing in vast meadows, whales frolicking in glistening

waters, or bears in their native habitat. In

Alaska, all that is possible—including glimpsing Denali National Park's Big Five: brown bears, wolves, moose, Dall sheep, and caribou.

Venture north to catch the sight of a mammoth forty-ton humpback whale breaking the surface of the water for air, or see something stir in the brush as a huge moose rises

from rest and wanders off. Moments like this only happen in Alaska—the Great Land.

Alaska has some of America's most stunning national gems—awe-inspiring Denali National

Park, home to North America's tallest peak, 20,310-foot Denali; Wrangell-St. Elias National Park, larger than the country of Switzerland; Glacier Bay National Park with towering Margerie Glacier; and beautiful Kenai Fjords National Park, with its glaciers and abundant marine life.

Get a glimpse of the welcoming personality of the Great Land by sailing into ports along the Inside Passage. Peek into the fascinating gold rush history that left its mark on the region's streets, saloons, and storefronts in cities

like Skagway, Sitka, Ketchikan and
Juneau. Visit Native villages, or go
dogsledding with a real musher. The
stories of The Inside Passage will
expand your understanding of its
culture, history, and lifestyle.



Rome, The Eternal City, is without a doubt one of the most beautiful cities in the world. Every year, millions of tourists come from everywhere to admire the treasures and masterpieces of Roman art and architecture.

The best times of the year to visit Rome are April, May, and late September through October.

Many Mediterranean cruises depart out of Rome via Civitavecchia, making the coastal city a perfect add-on to any pre/post cruise.

Tourists need at least 3-4 days to spend in Rome to see all the major attractions. Renting a car to get around Italy is a challenge, but driving around Rome is dangerous and I would not

recommend unless you have nerves of steel and the reflexes of a professional race car driver.

Thankfully, Rome has an efficient citywide transportation system, plus Uber.

Rome can accommodate any level of accommodations you're looking for, with all price ranges covered. There are many older, historic boutiquestyle hotels as well as more modern 5-star luxury resorts. To fully soak up

the history of this amazing city, consider staying near or in the historical area of Rome.

There's one thing in Rome you won't have to worry about: finding a good place to eat. Roman food is a popular, yet simple one. While not generally sophisticated or elaborate, it is generous, varied, and rich in flavors and character. And yes, there's pizza too!

From family-run trattorias and pizzerias to fancier, hip restaurants, Rome knows how to satiate your hunger and satisfy her visitors with her savory specialties.

You should always plan ahead when you travel, especially when it comes to seeing the sights in Rome. You can tour by yourself, in a small or large group. Visiting the Vatican is typically at least a half day, but many feel it should warrant a full day. Having a guide with you really enhances the experience. A good tour will also skip you to the front of the line.

The traditional historical venues—the Colosseum, Pantheon, Forum, and St Peter's Basilica—really bring you the truest sense of ancient Rome. There are passes that you can purchase to get into these attractions, or, of course, you can book a private guide who is properly trained to make all that history come to life.

Tevi Fountain. Dominating the small, cobbled avenue in which it sits, the fountain is an outrageous example of over-the-top Barogue sculpture.







Everyone should visit Jamaica at least once in their lifetime.

Jamaica's motto is "Out of many, one people." It is one of the most culturally rich and diverse countries in the world, from the music, food, dressing, and other forms of Jamaican heritage.

Whether you're on a cruise or staying at an amazing resort, Jamaica is the ideal location to spend your vacation or honeymoon. Jerk is a style of cooking where cuts of meat and seafood are slathered in an allspice and scotch bonnet marinade and smoked over hot coals.

There are so many things to do in Jamaica, from immersion in street culture, interacting with nationals, learning the Patois/Jamaican

Creole language, art walks, concerts, tours, and excursions.

Jamaica is known as the land of wood and water, with attractions both inland and off the coasts. You can go hiking, climbing the Blue Mountains, rafting on the Martha Brae or Rio Grande, camping out in the forest, connecting with nature, and meet indigenous people.

You will be amazed by exotic wildlife you've never seen. Nature lovers will have boundless opportunities to learn **Visit** about Jamaican flora and fauna.

Negril Beach, also known as Seven Mile Beach, is one of the most popular in the world. White water cascades down a 180ft (55m) flight of natural rock stairs at Dunn's River Falls, near Ocho Rios. Visitors can climb these stairs, stopping to

soak in natural pools and shower in the falls' foamy water along the way.

If scaling the falls isn't adventurous enough for you, there's also a zip-line circuit that features seven zip-lines and four hanging bridges.

So come live it up— Jamaican style. The heartbeat of the world.
